## **Application Checklist**

In order to successfully apply to the ESL Summer Camp, please send the following items to St. Stanislaus by email, fax or postal service before February 24, 2012. Depending on the country you are applying from, it could take as much as three months to obtain a visa from the United States Embassy.

- Application Form
- Health Form
- Copy of Passport
- \$100 Application Fee (You may pay by check, credit card or bank transfer.)

After we receive the items above, we will send you a letter to let you know if you have been accepted to the ESL Summer Camp.

## **Visa Interview**

In order to attend the ESL Summer Camp, you will need to apply for a non-immigrant, tourist visa with the United States Embassy in your country. Please visit the Embassy's website in your country to find out more information about how to apply for a visa.

The following are suggested documents that you may wish to present to support your visa application. Please note, however, that presenting these documents does not guarantee that you will receive a visa. Please read the list carefully, and if you decide to present any of the documents, present only those that pertain to your particular case. If possible, present original documents. This list is by no means an exhaustive list; you should bring whatever documents you think are relevant to your case.

Documents from the United States, such as invitation letters, may be useful to clarify the reasons for your proposed travel but are not as important as those that indicate your economic, social, family, and professional ties to your country.

Documents related to your employment, such as letter from your employer stating:

- your job title
- how long you have been employed
- your monthly salary
- how many days of leave are granted for your trip
- pay stubs

Documents related to your financial situation, such as:

- original bank statements for the last several months
- deeds to any property you own
- Your country's tax documentation
- chambers of commerce registrations, etc.

Documents related to your school situation, such as:

- report cards
- tuition payment receipts
- letter of support from a teacher or principal

Documents related to international travel in the past, such as

- airplane ticket stubs
- hotel reservation receipts
- pictures

### **After you receive a tourist visa**

- Send us a copy of your tourist visa by email or fax.
- Purchase your round-trip airplane ticket and send us a copy by email or fax.
- Send us the ESL Camp payment(s) according to the Financial Data Sheet.
